ORDINANCE 20.02 AMENDMENT: Councilman Lindley made a motion to approve the amendment to Ordinance 20.02 in regards to updated rate changes. Councilman Crutchfield seconded. All in favor. Motion passed.

ORDINANCE 11.28: Councilman Lindley made a motion to approve Ordinance 11.28 authorizing the issuance of City of Mertzon, Texas Water and Sewer System Revenue Note, Taxable Series 2024; providing for the security for and payment of such note; and authorizing and enacting other matters and provisions relating to the subject. RESOLUTION 10-21-24 B: Councilman Councilman made a motion to approve Resolution 10-21-24B authorizing and directing establishment of funds and accounts with Depository Bank pursuant to a Note Ordinance and a Principal Forgiveness Agreement with the Texas Water Development Board; appointing authorized signatories with respect to such funds and accounts; and resolving other matters relating to the subject.
